






#### **ADULTS CURRENTLY USE (2014-2015)**

**AMONG ALL CURRENT ADULT USERS:** •45.7% reported using marijuana daily or near daily •17.5% reported driving after using.








#### **COMPARING CURRENT USE BY COLORADO ADULTS BY YEAR**




#### **ADOLESCENTS CURRENTLY USE (2015)**

## **EXPOSURE AMONG CHILDREN**



(2014 - 2015)Of parents,

■ 3.2<sup>%</sup> live in homes where any marijuana had recently been used inside; ■ 1.9% live in homes where marijuana had recently been smoked inside.

■ 7.4% report keeping marijuana in or around the home.

■ 11.2% used marijuana in the three months before pregnancy; ■ 4.8% used marijuana while pregnant; ■ 5.3% have used marijuana since giving birth.
